Among the most magnificent, breathtaking and popular hiking circuits of the Chilean Patagonia -and maybe the whole world, the W is first on the list because it traverses the main attractions of Torres del Paine National Park. Why is it called the W? Because its layout connects three large valleys: Ascencio, Francés and Grey Glacier.

You will see the massive granite towers up close that give the Park its name and walk alongside the striking shapes and colors of Los Cuernos del Paine. You will be amazed by the nuances and incredible views of the Francés Valley lookout points, and awe-inspired by the magnificent Grey Glacier, the southernmost tip of the Chilean Patagonia's Southern Ice Fields, where the ice blends into the clouds on the horizon.

This is an invitation to connect with the landscapes, colors and grandeur of the Eighth Wonder of the World in the most comfortable way the Park could offer!

ITINERARY Option 1

6 days, 5 nights

Day 1: Transportation to Torres del Paine National Park

A private shuttle will pick you up at the airport or your hotel to take you to Torres del Paine National Park (approx. 400 km away). We will stop on the way to enjoy a traditional Patagonian cordero al palo (spit-roasted lamb), get to experience ranch activities, or enjoy a typical Chilean teatime, the "once" (depending on departure time from Punta Arenas). Then, we will continue our trip to the park. We will have dinner and sleep at Hotel Las Torres.

Day 2: Hike to Las Torres Base

ITINERARY Option 2

6 days, 5 nights

Day 1: Transportation to the Park, Grey Lake Navigation

A private shuttle will pick you up at the airport or your hotel to take you to the Torres del Paine National Park (approx. 400 km away). We will arrive at the Grey Lake Pier, where we will take the catamaran to the Grey Mountain Refuge, where we will have dinner and sleep.

Day 2: Suspension bridges and hike to Paine Grande

After breakfast, we will hike approximately 8 km to the suspension bridges, but If you prefer, you can take a kayak trip to the Grey Glacier or go on an ice hike (both excursions are not included in the program and must be booked in advance).

Then, we will continue our route to the Paine Grande Mountain Refuge (11 km).

Day 4: Hike to Central Sector

Today will be much easier. We will walk 11 km from the Cuernos Sector to the Central Sector, and arrive in time for lunch to the Hotel Las Torres. In the afternoon, we will have time to unwind and enjoy a Patagonian cordero al palo (spit-roasted lamb) at the gazebo. We recommend you to enjoy a well-deserved massage at the hotel's Spa (not included in the program).

Day 5: Hike to Grey Sector and Suspension Bridges

Today, we will reach the third milestone of the circuit, a spot that offers unforgettable scenery of the park: the wonderful Grey Glacier. We will stop for lunch at the Grey Sector and then continue on our way to the suspension bridges, from where we will be able to take incredible pictures of the glacier. If you prefer, you can stay at the Grey sector to make an excursion such as kayaking or ice hiking at the (the excursions are not included in the program and must be booked in advance).

Day 6: Return to Punta Arenas


After breakfast, we will check out and take the shuttle back to Punta Arenas.

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

- For program option N° 2, you must be in Punta Arenas no later than 12:00 pm in order to take the last catamaran to the Grey Mountain Refuge.
- Excursions must be booked at least 10 days in advance.
- According to the Tax Code, if you are an international guest, you must provide your Passport and Immigration Form (given by the Immigration Officer upon arrival to the country) to benefit from the 19% VAT exemption.
- If the documents are not provided upon check-in, the tax will be charged in CLP at the beginning of the program.
